



Safety Plan: As a Parent/Carer this is **your** responsibility.





Keep them safe In the Community

	<p>Where is my child? Who are they with? Check in with your child regularly when they are out in the community. Thought about a phone tracker?</p>
	<p>Do they have credit on their phone? Make sure their phone is charged up so they can reach you.</p>
	<p>Are their friends around the same age? Get to know their friends/parents, where do they live.</p>
	<p>Does your child go to other properties? Do not let your child sleep or visit unknown properties unless you have spoken to an appropriate adult there.</p>



If your child does not turn up and cannot be traced call the Police on 101, unless you feel your child is in **immediate danger call **999**.**

Safety Plan: As a Parent/Carer this is **your** responsibility.
Keep them safe Online

	<p>Always check your child's activity online and make sure they are using age-appropriate sites. Take an interest in what they do online.</p>
	<p>Check that your child has not got any personal information online. (Phone number, address, school, also any pictures that display their school uniform).</p>
	<p>Sending or receiving inappropriate images/videos, is an offence (inform your child of this).</p>
	<p>Check they know the friends they have on applications in real life. Be aware of who they talk to online and check their friends list regularly.</p>



PARENTAL CONTROL

Protect your child/children, set up appropriate applications for your child, along with **parental controls, making sure you have access to their applications, passwords/numbers.**
